Title: For some California students, hunger is part of the college experience

Summary: The study, based on U.S. Census data from 2001 to 2015, found that households with two-year college students were consistently more likely to be “food-insecure” during that period, especially after the 2008 recession.

Every Wednesday, about 500 **Sacramento City College** students stop by to pick up fresh produce delivered by the Sacramento Food Bank, which is distributed farmers' market-style by students.
